

Professional Portrait Program Photographer Guidelines

Background, Lighting and Camera Orientation

- Use a white seamless background
- Use professional lights to create a classic portrait lighting pattern with no strong shadows or blown highlights on the subject
- Orient the camera vertically

Posing, Composition and Tone



- Pose the subject with arms at sides
- Some but not all frames may be posed with arms crossed or hands on hips
- Photograph the subject from the waist up
- Photograph the subject at eye level
- Loosely frame the subject
- Do not crop the shoulders
- Direct the subject to convey a professional, friendly and approachable tone

File Size and Format Requirements

- Final image(s) must be uncropped
- Schwab retouches all portraits in house, so any retouching by the photographer should be minimal
- Final image(s) must be high-resolution (300 ppi) and at least 6 inches in height
- Send files in a JPEG file format
- It is helpful for file names to include the subject's first and last name but that is not imperative
- ✓ Final image(s) must be emailed as an attachment to portraits@schwab.com
- √ Photographers must sign the release on the following page
- ✓ Attach a scan or photo of the signed release form in the email with the image
- ✓ Include the **subject's first and last name** in the file name or email message
